

## **Regulations for Approved Camping sites**

### **Arrival to the campsite**

Upon arrival guests must check-in at the reception – this includes visitors for residents of the camping site. Prepayment is required. Should you arrive outside of opening hours of the reception, you are most welcome to park, but check-in is required when the reception opens.

### **Stays on the Site**

The camp warden and staff are responsible for order at the camping site and are available to assist should problems arise.

The camp warden's instructions are to be followed at all times.

Please show consideration to other campers and be aware that noisy behaviour is not permitted.

Between 11 pm and 7 am, the site must be quiet and music be turned off by 10 pm.

During your stay, driving must be restricted to essential drives and should be at walking pace (under 15 km/h). The driving entry to the site will be closed in the evening.

Driving on grass areas is not permitted between 15 October and 1 April.

Only ordinary tents and tent extensions on caravans may be used. The use of tent houses with fixed walls, windows and doors is not allowed.

A storage tent (approximately 3 m<sup>2</sup>) may be erected with the camp warden's permission. Windscreens, generally available for sale, may be erected, but any other enclosure of individual pitches is not permitted. Flagpoles, antennas etc. are not permitted. Digging on your unit space may only be done with an agreement from the camp warden.

Usage of any form of weapons or fireworks are strictly prohibited on the camping site.

Commerce on the camping site is only accepted with the camp warden's permission.

Communal facilities, i.e. toilets, wash houses, kitchens, etc., should be left in the same condition as you would like to find them - clean and tidy.

We recommend always using the garbage containers set up on site.

### **Camping sites Playing Facilities**

Help your children to find places where they can play. Ball games and rough games is not permitted between tents and caravans.

### **Dogs**

Dogs must be on a short leash. They must not be unnecessarily noisy and they must be walked outside the site or in a designated area. Always bring a plastic bag for any unforeseen accidents.

### **Departure**

Unless otherwise arranged with the camp warden, your pitch or cabin should be vacated no later than 12 noon in a clean and tidy state. In case of extending your stay, it should be done no later than 10 am at the reception.

### **Liability**

The camping warden assume no responsibility for damages or loss of campers' property. Anyone damaging the buildings, equipment or fellow campers' property is liable to pay damages in accordance with current rules for damage liability. In case of violations of the rules or lack of payment, expulsion will apply. Please show both respect and protection to nature and the environment – as both elements depend on your protection.
